



This shawl is worked from the top down with a centre insertion panel which creates a lovely shape that sits nicely on the shoulders. The shawl is shaped by working increases at the beginning, end, and either side of the central insertion, on every other row.

MATERIALS

1 skein SweetGeorgia CashSilk Lace in Oceanside (400 yds / 365 m per 1.76 oz / 50 g skein; 55% Silk, 45% Cashmere).

NEEDLES

Size US 4 / 3.5mm, 32" / 80 cm long circular needles. *Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.*

Size E / 3.5mm crochet hook (for crochet edging)

NOTIONS

30gr size 8/0 seed beads (approximately 1,120 beads), 0.50 mm crochet hook (for adding beads), stitch markers, tapestry needle

SKILL

Intermediate

GAUGE

20 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in chart D, after blocking. *Exact gauge is not essential but a change in gauge may affect the finished size of the shawl and the amount of yarn needed.*

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 50" / 127 cm

Depth: 19" / 48 cm

ABBREVIATIONS

K	knit
P	purl

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TO ADD BEAD:

Place the bead on the crochet hook, lift the st off the LH ndl, slide the bead onto the st and place the st back on the LH ndl and k.

PATTERN

Cast on 21 sts. Knit one row.

Row 1: K2, work Row 1 of chart A, k1, work Row 1 of chart C, k1, work Row 1 of chart A, k2.

Row 2 and all WS rows throughout: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: K2, work Row 3 of chart A, k1, work Row 3 of chart C, k1, work Row 3 of chart A, k2.

Continue to work as set through all 12 rows of chart C.

Next row (RS): K2, work Row 13 of chart A, k1, work Row 1 of chart D, k1, work Row 13 of chart A, k2.

Continue to work as set to end of chart A and all 20 rows of chart D.

Next row (RS): K2, work Row 1 of chart B, k1, work Row 1 of chart D, k1, work Row 1 of chart B, k2.

Continue to work as set through all 20 rows of chart B and chart D 5 times. Do not break yarn. 297 sts.

CROCHET CHAIN CAST OFF:

Using E / 3.5 mm crochet hook, insert hook into first 5 sts purlwise, yo and pull through all loops, ch10, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) four times, [(insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) three times, insert hook into next 5 sts, yo and pull through all loops, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) twice] rep to 18 sts before 'spine st', (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops) five times, insert hook into next 6 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) seven times, insert hook into next 6 sts, yo

and pull through all loops, ch10, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) 5 times, [(insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) twice, insert hook into next 5 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) three times] rep to last 17 sts, (insert hook into next 3 sts, yo and pull through all loops, ch10) four times, insert hook into last 5 sts, yo and pull through all loops. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends. To wet block, soak shawl in lukewarm water for at least 20 minutes. Squeeze out excess water. Stretch shawl out to size and shape and pin in place. Leave to dry.

WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS FOR LACE CHARTS

CHART A

Row 1 (RS): yo, k1, yo.

Row 2 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: yo, k3, yo.

Row 5: yo, k5, yo.

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Row 7: yo, k7, yo.

Row 9: yo, k9, yo.

Row 11: yo, k11, yo.

Row 13: yo, k1, yo, ssk, k7, k2tog, yo, k1, yo.

Row 15: yo, k3, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k3, yo.

Row 17: yo, k1, k2tog, (k1, yo) twice, ssk, k3, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 19: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 21: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 23: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 25: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 27: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k2, B, k6, yo.

Row 29: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k6, yo.

Row 31: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2, B, k6, yo.

CHART C

Row 1 (RS): yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k2, yo.

Row 2 & all WS rows: k2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 5: yo, (k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk) twice, k1, yo.

Row 7: yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, B, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, B, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 9: yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 11: yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, B, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3, B, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo.

CHART D

Row 1 (RS): yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, B, k1, k2tog, B, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, B, ssk, k1, B, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo.

Row 2 & all WS rows: k2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, B, k1, k2tog, B, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, B, ssk, k1, B, k1, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo.

Row 5: yo, ssk, yo, k1, B, k1, k2tog, B, k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, B, ssk, k1, B, k1, yo, k2tog, yo.

Row 7: yo, ssk, yo, k1, B, k1, ssk, B, k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, B, k2tog, k1, B, k1, yo, k2tog, yo.

Row 9: yo, ssk, k1, yo, k1, B, k1, ssk, B, k1, yo,

ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, B, k2tog, k1, B, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, yo.

Row 11: yo, ssk, k2, yo, k1, B, k1, ssk, B, k1, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, B, k2tog, k1, B, k1, yo, k2, k2tog, yo.

Row 13: yo, ssk, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, B, k1, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, k1, B, (k1, yo) twice, ssk, k2tog, yo.

Row 15: yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, B, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, B, k3, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo.

Row 17: (yo, ssk) twice, k1, B, (k1, k2tog, yo) twice, (k1, yo, ssk) twice, k1, B, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice.

Row 19: yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, B, k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, yo, ssk, B, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo.

CHART B

Row 1 (RS): yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3, [k4, k2tog, yo, k9, yo, ssk, k3], k4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo.

Row 2 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2, [k3, k2tog, yo, k11, yo, ssk, k2], k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo.

Row 5: yo, k1, k2tog, (k1, yo) twice, ssk, k1, [k2, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, ssk, k5, k2tog, (k1, yo) twice, ssk, k1], k2, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 7: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, ssk, [k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, ssk], k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 9: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, yo, [sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, yo], sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 11: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, [k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, sl1, k2tog, pssso, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo], k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 13: yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, [k2, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1], k2, yo, ssk, k2, B, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo.

Row 15: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, [k3, yo, ssk, k2, B, k5, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k2], k3, yo, ssk, k2, B, k6, yo.

Row 17: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, [k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k3, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk], k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, B, k6, yo.

Row 19: yo, k6, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, [sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2, B, k1, B, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo], sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, yo,

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

slip one as if to knit, knit 2 sts together, pass slipped st over





